Transportation Study Technical and Coordinating Committee Meeting

October 25th, 2023 Minutes

At 1:02pm, Chris Chapman opened the meeting.

Mr. Chapman noted that, per the Sunshine Act requirements, the meeting and agenda were advertised in the Scranton Times, Citizens Voice, and Hazleton Standard Speaker and the meeting time and agenda were posted on the LLTS MPO website more than 24 hours prior to the meeting.

1. PP, LEP, Title VI Plans Public Comment Meeting (1:00-1:15) – Public comment on the draft PPP, LEP, and Title VI Plans.

Mr. Chapman asked that Brian Funkhouser present the work Michael Baker had completed to date. Mr. Funkhouser gave a presentation regarding the Public Participation Plan, the Title VI Plan, and the Limited English Proficiency Plan. Mr. Funkhouser stated that there was a forty-five-day public comment period opened for the plans and there were no public comments received. Matt Jones gave comment stating that there would be another amendment proposed to add to the plan that would better accommodate community members and help drive public participation.

4b. Fall Planning Partners

Mr. Roberts stated that there are surveys available regarding the Fall Planning Partners conference. Mr. Chapman gave a brief description of what was covered during the conference.

4c. Federal Certification Review

Gene Porochniak stated that late June or early July would likely be the time for the site visit. He also stated that there should be a meeting set in the future to further discuss the federal certification review process.

4d. Funding/Grant Opportunities

Mr. Chapman explained that the PennDOT multi-modal fun is open until November 13th, and it encompasses funding for any bike facilities and non-motorized travel options. Mr. Chapman also spoke about the TASA grant program. Projects have been submitted and there will be a meeting on how to score projects that will be presented on November 16th at the 911 center in Jessup. Mr. Roberts asked how many projects will be presented. Mr. Chapman responded stating that there would be seven projects presented for the TASA program. Multimodal Transportation Fund (MTF)

4e. Safe Streets and Roads for All [SS4A] Awards

Mr. Chapman stated that Luzerne County was awarded \$200,00 for an SS4A Action plan grant. He also stated that they will be looking for a consultant on the project and that the county will be releasing an RFP. Mary Liz Donato commented that Lackawanna County will be looking to get an RFP released sometime in January for the SS4A grant Lackawanna County was awarded.

5. Progress Reports

5a. PennDOT Connects

Mr. Fisher reviewed the compilation of projects that PennDOT will need to work on regarding outreach for PennDOT connects. Mr. Fisher also stated that there would be technical assistance available in the future for any planning or programing projects.

5b. Joint County Plans for 2023

Mr. Chapman reviewed the Public Participation Plan, Title VI Plan/Limited-English Proficiency Plan, Congestion Management Process, and Coordinated Public Transit – Human Services Transportation Plan. The

public comment period is set to close on the 26th of October. Mr. Chapman stated that there would be meetings for the upcoming plans for the committees that were created to oversee the process.

5c. 2024-2025 UPWP Update

Mr. Chapman reminded that there would be a one-year cycle and Lackawanna and Luzerne County staff had met to discuss the process moving forward. He also stated that the UPWP would be up for approval during the January meeting.

5d. LCTA Micro transit Update

Ms. Bednarek presented the micro transit update and stated that there had been funding left from FHWA that is currently in an FTA grant application, there is also an effort to work off other successful micro transit programs.

5e. Eastern PA Freight Alliance Freight Study

Mr. Chapman stated that the freight study is still moving forward and will hopefully be completed by mid-next year. There was good feedback at the stakeholder meeting held by NEPA Alliance. LLTS will be holding a stakeholder meeting soon and Mr. Chapman requested that anyone with contacts for possible stakeholders please provide that information.
